



4.8.2. International flight connections

International commercial flights to and from Damascus were being operated to several countries including Türkiye, Iraq, United Arab Emirates, Kuwait, Jordan,[1060](#) Qatar, Saudi Arabia,[1061](#) Libya, Oman[1062](#) and Romania.[1063](#) Following the escalation of hostilities across the Middle East after 28 February 2026, the Syrian airspace was closed on 1 March.[1064](#) Operations resumed at Aleppo International Airport on 4 March,[1065](#) while the reopening of all air corridors and of Damascus International Airport was announced on 8 April.[1066](#) Temporary closures of Syrian airspace were reported again in early June 2026 in response to the renewed exchange of attacks between Israel and Iran.[1067](#)

Starting with 28 February 2026, Israeli and Iranian forces have exchanged strikes through Syrian airspace, resulting in civilian casualties, disruption of services and damage to property,[1068](#) particularly in southern Syria.[1069](#)
